ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom, Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come — Greeting

WHEREAS healthcare auxiliaries in British Columbia are local organizations that represent dedicated adult and youth volunteers who help to enhance the care and comfort of patients and their families, and help raise funds to improve and support healthcare in local communities in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS the BC Association of Healthcare Auxiliaries (BCAHA) works to provide healthcare auxiliaries in British Columbia with education, information, resources and support, and

WHEREAS the BCAHA promotes best practices and the exchange of ideas among member auxiliaries, to keep members current and connected, and

WHEREAS the BCAHA promotes the recruitment and support of youth volunteers at member auxiliaries, and recognizes the work of youth volunteers by offering bursaries and scholarships each year to students seeking financial assistance;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 7, 2022, shall be known as

"Healthcare Auxiliaries Day"

in the Province of British Columbia.
